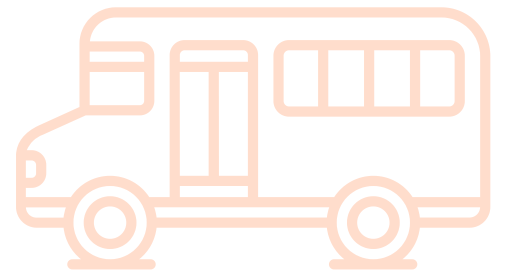

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About our Social Trips



Our trips are designed to suit all types of people and fitness levels. Each trip has a specific fitness rating so you know exactly what to expect. Follow this helpful guide, which you'll find next to each trip, to know which ones are right for you.

To attend our Social Trips you must:

1. Register as a client with our Community Transport
2. Provide your My Aged Care number
3. Call 07 4169 8400 to book

Fitness Level of Trips

We have also now included the approximate amount of times you will be required to transfer on/off the bus. You must be capable of confidently and competently doing this on your own without any assistance to attend trips. Please note that the front seat of the bus is reserved for an extra volunteer assistant, making our care ratio 4:1.



Easy - these trips are suitable for people with walking aids including wheelie-walkers and wheelchairs and are low impact. You must be capable of getting on and off the bus unassisted.

Pick up locations:

We have designated pick up zones for our bus and people movers to keep pick ups moving efficiently along our route. If you cannot get to one of our designated pick up zones, a small number of home pick ups are available.

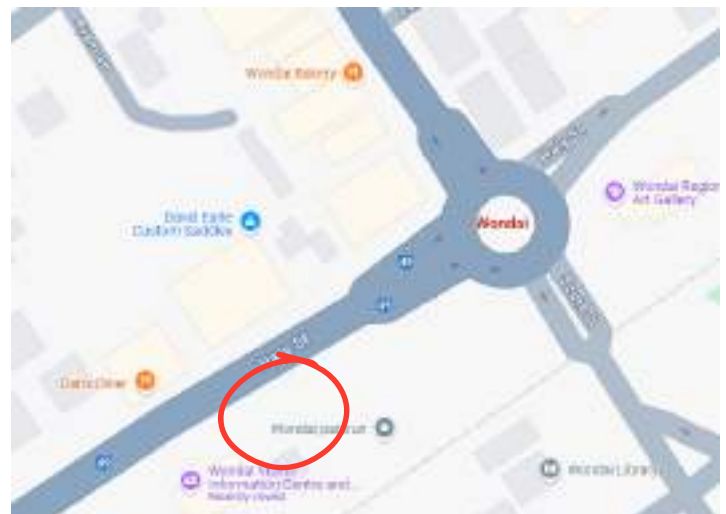

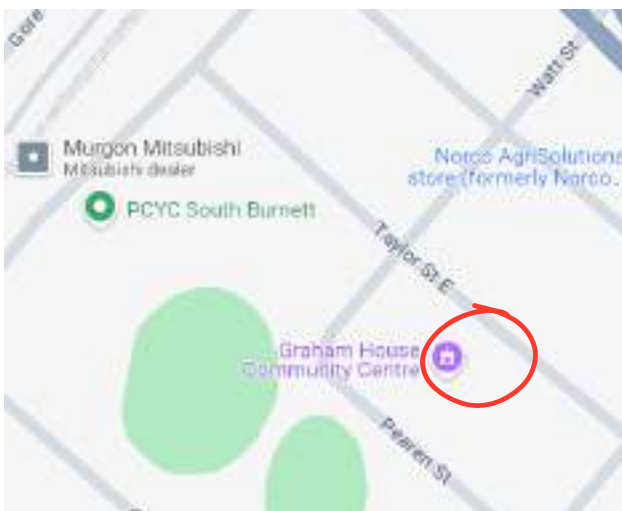

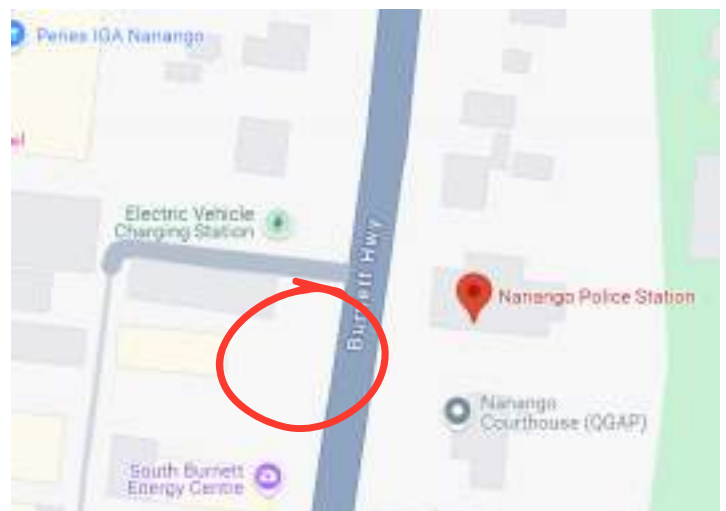

Important Information

Bookings are essential

Our social trips are extremely popular and seats are limited, therefore bookings are essential.

We will confirm your pick up time and arrangements closer to your trip date. If you miss out and all seats are fully booked, we will place you on the wait list in case of cancellations.

Payments and Inclusions

Pre-payment for social trips is preferred, however cash can be given to the driver on the day if the trip is transport only. Trips where lunch/tours are included in the price must be pre-paid to Graham House. This can be done by credit card over the phone or cash or card in person.

Please read each trip carefully for inclusions - some are transport only, some include morning tea, lunch and tours. Ensure you bring some additional money for purchases.

Cancellations

Please contact us as soon as possible if you need to cancel, and make arrangements for a refund/credit. If trips are cancelled within 48 hours of scheduled pick up time, we can only offer a 50% refund/credit. If cancelled with more notice than this, often we can offer a refund/credit of 100%.

Spirit of the Bush Festival Boodooma Homestead, Proston



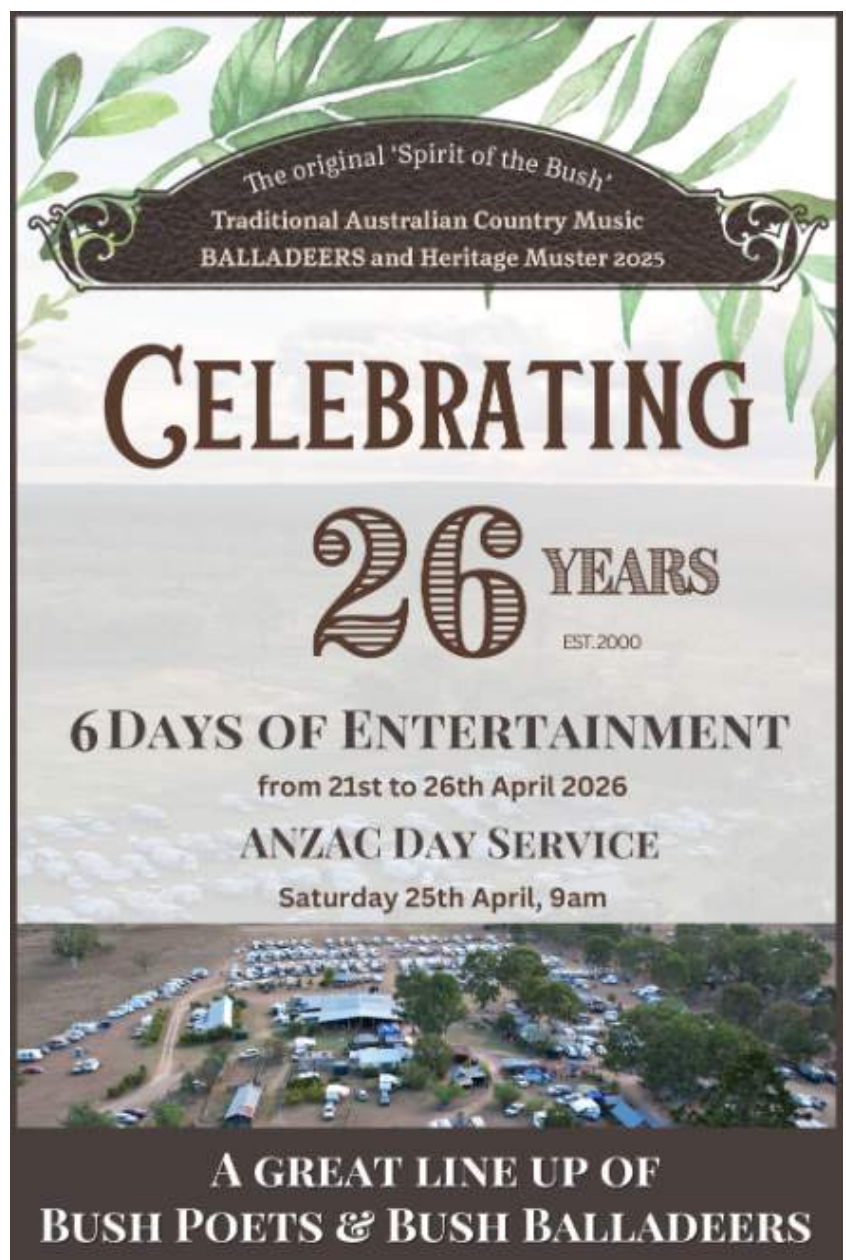

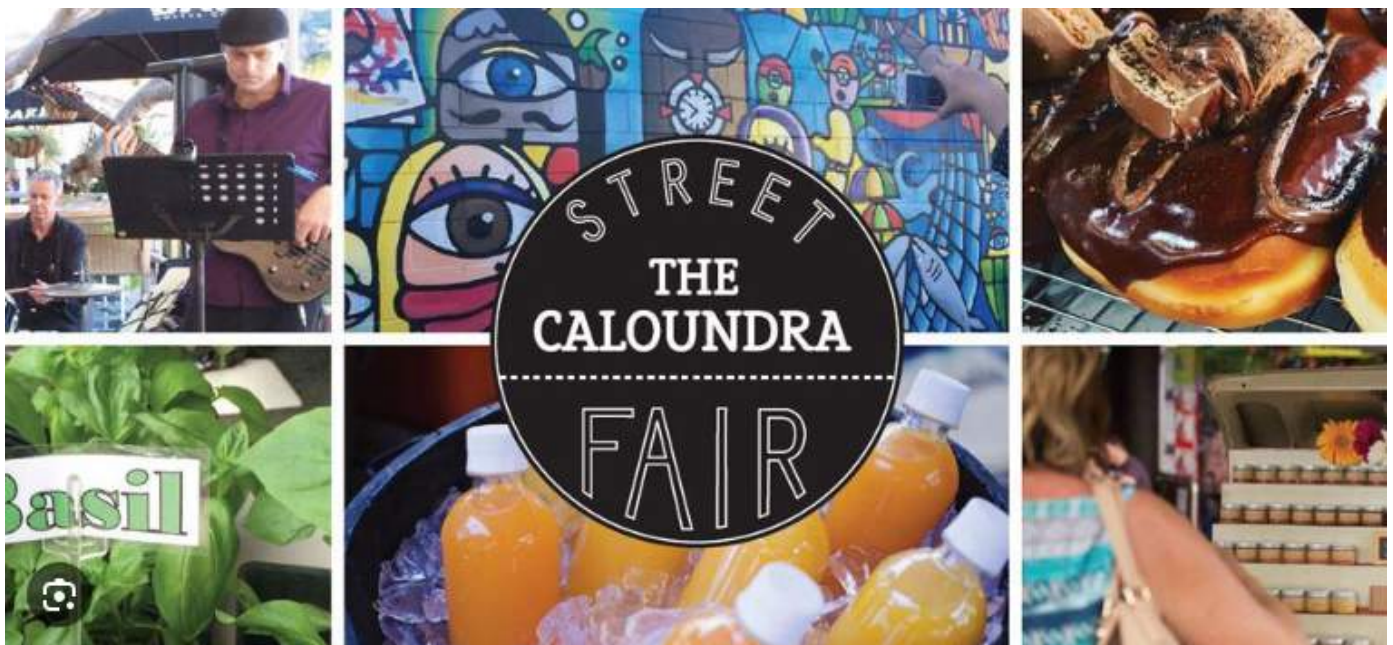

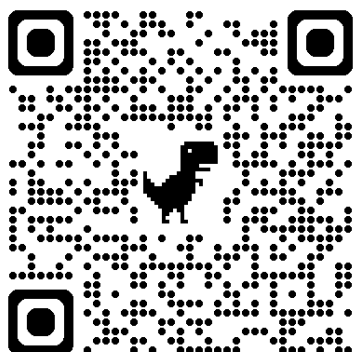
